The combination of changes to the original Silver Shadow introduced in 1977 was sufficient for Rolls-Royce to dub the new model 'Shadow II'. The upgrades included a switch to rack-and-pinion steering, revised front end suspension geometry, new carburetors, and revised exhaust and cooling fans all aimed at improving fuel consumption. More visible alterations included rubber-tipped bumpers, a deeper radiator shell and door handles with more deeply recessed buttons. Still more evident was the bib spoiler below the front bumper and new style (spring-back) door mirror that was adjustable from inside the car.
