#### 1968 Bond Equipe 2-Litre

- Based on the Triumph Herald, the Bond Equipe was a 2+2 sports car that was designed to be competitively priced against much more expensive rivals. First introduced in 1963 and styled by Lawrie Bond, the Equipe utilised the chassis, windscreen, scuttle assembly and the doors from the Herald, but otherwise the fibreglass body was entirely new. Offered as both a fastback GT and a convertible, the design of the Equipe was a surprisingly successful blend of subtle Herald styling cues but with a much sleeker body.

Manufactured in 1968, this Bond was supplied new to the United Kingdom, being first registered on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of August that year. Fitted with the 1998cc Triumph straight-six engine with the four-speed manual transmission, the Bond is finished in Dark Blue with Black interior upholstery. Converted at some stage in its life from the original GT format into a convertible as seen here, the Equipe has a recorded mileage of some 89,751 miles at the time of consignment. Recommissioned in 2021 following a period of time laid up, the Equipe has been used regularly in current ownership and is offered with some previous MOT certificates and tax discs, invoices for the recent works completed, current V5C and an assortment of spare parts.
