- Starts well with either kickstarter or electric starter

The Honda Motor Company was founded by Soichiro Honda in 1937, initially producing piston rings for Toyota. They made their first motorcycle in 1949 and within 10 years had become the biggest motorcycle manufacturer in the world. They have gone on to produce over 400 million two-wheelers as well as millions of other power products. The CB175 was one of the best selling bikes of the early seventies giving many learner motorcyclists their first taste of riding a bigger bike on a typically well built and reliable Honda.

This 1973 CB175 still retains many of its original parts and the vendor reports that it is in 'good working order' and starts easily on either the electric starter or kickstarter. This would have been a classic learner or 'go to work' bike in its day so whilst it sold in large numbers not many have survived today. A nice simple bike that will be easy to maintain for classic runs and rallies. It comes supplied with a current V5C registration document.
