The 90s was arguably the heyday of the Japanese performance car, with most manufacturers from the Land of the Rising Sun producing more than one hot model. In stark contrast to today, Toyota was the prime mover - with three proper sports cars in the range. But whilst the MR2 and Supra may have grabbed the majority of the attention, it was the Celica that garnered the most motorsport success.

Manufactured in 1995, this GT 2000 is thought to have been supplied to Japan, before being imported into the United Kingdom and registered on the 1st of April 2006. Fitted with the 1998cc four-cylinder engine allied to a five-speed manual transmission, the Toyota is finished Silver with Grey cloth interior upholstery. Displaying a recorded mileage of some 112,000 miles, since entering the UK, the Celica has had seven former keepers. Fitted with a touch-screen entertainment system, it has benefitted from a recent alloy wheel refurbishment, replacement alternator, and a new exhaust and battery. 'N730 BRC' is offered with a current V5C document, a number of previous MOTs dating back to 2013, and an MOT certificate until June 2023.
